Elderly Service

- 1) According to SWD's notification on 14 September, 2020, in view of the latest epidemic situation, subsidised welfare services operated by non-governmental organisations (NGOs) will be resumed by phases. The running of groups and small-scale programmes, such as talks, will be resumed on a pre-scheduled and appointment basis, with proper infection control measures put in place and subject to the prohibition on group gatherings in force at the time under the Prevention and Control of Disease. We will continue to conduct some groups through visual or online means. No drop-in is allowed for the time being.
- 2) We continue to show our concern for those vulnerable elderly by phone calls. Apart from delivering face masks, disinfection liquid, cleansing materials and food to nearly 900 elderly people. Up to date, we have delivered more than 77,000 pieces of face masks to the elderly. The face masks came from the Centre's own resources and donation of groups and individuals, including brothers and sisters of Lung Hang Church and Kin Sang Church. We are so grateful to supply from God. We welcome donation of face masks. We will arrange to give them to elderly in need. Please pray that the Lord will continue to supply us with what we need, and give us the wisdom and power to guard those who lack the resources to protect their health.
- 3) We have joined the charity sale of The Care for the Elderly Charity Ticket in the period from 24 October 2020 to 29 November 2020. Due to COVID-19, we decided to cancel all sales on streets, but only through individual or internet promotions and sales. The target of fund raising is \$400,000. Please pray for God's supply and support.
